

# 2006 ESTATE PINOT NOIR

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## WINEMAKING

**Fruit** – Selectively hand picked estate grown fruit from our Dixon's Creek Vineyard. Cropping levels adjusted to 2.5 tonnes per acre.

**Winemaking** – French oak barriques were used to age this wine for 10 months.

**Made at** – Yering Station

**Quantity** – 500 Dozen

**Alcohol** – 14%

**Closure** – Screwcap

## TASTING NOTE

**Colour** - Ruby centre with a garnet rim.

**Nose** - Hints of cloves, strawberry, ripe yellow melon, plum, and dried rose petals.

**Palate** - Brown baking spice, stewed strawberry, black cherry skin, ripe plums, creamy with slight chappy oak character.
